Training Agreement

Services provided: Sessions will be taught by Emily Gaydos, dba The Clicker Coach ("Trainer"). Classes are limited to 8 dogs so that personal attention may be provided to each dog-handler team; if class sizes are larger, a qualified Assistant Trainer may be employed at the Trainer's discretion. Trainer, at her discretion, may refuse entry to any dog which is aggressive, unhealthy, in season, or which in any way does not seem suited to the services offered.

Payment: Payment is due prior to the start of training.

Rescheduling/Cancellations: Due to the nature of the class, it is not possible to reschedule lessons. No refunds will be given for missed sessions.

Bad Weather: Trainer will make every good faith effort to hold class sessions and complete the series as scheduled, but cannot guarantee that every session will be held as scheduled. In the event of weather unsuitable for training, class sessions may be postponed until the same day and time the following week.

Removal from training: Trainer may, at her sole discretion, remove a pet from class if a hazard or threat of any nature to any other animal or person is present. No refunds will be given under such circumstances.

Danger to Trainer: This class is not suitable for aggressive dogs. Owner agrees that s/he has represented the history of the dog accurately and truthfully. Failure to notify Trainer of dangerous behavior from owner's pet prior to or during the period of training will result in immediate cancellation of all sessions with no refund.

Assumption of Risk: Classes may be held at any location the Trainer deems suitable. Owner agrees to indemnify and hold the owners of any location, its employees and agents ("Location") and Trainer harmless from all liability for any loss, damage, or injury to persons, animals or property arising from or related to Owner's pet or other pets in class. Owner agrees that Location and/or Trainer shall not be liable for loss or damage to said animal, persons, animals or property unless said loss or damage was a direct result of Trainer's negligence.

Arbitration: Any controversy between the parties involving any of the terms, covenants, or conditions of this Agreement shall be submitted to arbitration in Siskiyou County, California, on the request of any party, and shall comply with and be governed by the provisions of the American Arbitration Association. All decisions shall be final and binding. In any dispute between the parties, whether or not resulting in litigation, the party substantially prevailing shall be entitled to recover from the other parties all reasonable costs, including without limitation, attorney's fees.
